

Academic Track

Scholarly Track Requirements:

All residents will participate in a one hour monthly meeting during Grand Rounds time for their specific track which may include applicable reading with discussion, didactics or evaluation of their progress.

- 1.) Complete at least **one** of the following:
 - a.) Write an outside grant application
 - b.) Present an abstract at SAEM or other national meeting
 - c.) Conduct a complete research project from protocol to manuscript submission to a peer reviewed medical journal

- 2.) Attend a full SAEM meeting including attendance at 5 lectures on research/teaching

- 3.) Develop a clinical lecture that can be presented regularly for departmental medical student lectures (minimum 10 presentations)

- 4.) 9 – 6 hour shifts during 3rd year as a bedside clinical instructor to medical students, EM1 or rotators

- 5.) Complete **one** of the following (planning, implementation & evaluation):
 - a.) CPC Presentation
 - b.) Journal Club moderator
 - c.) Procedure Lab instructor
 - d.) Simulation Center Instructor

- 6.) Complete **one** of the following:
 - a.) Participate on a national level SAEM committee/interest group
 - b.) Instructor certification in ACLS/ATLS or PALS
